2018 POOL SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are enforced for the safety of all members and their guests. Rules & Regulations are subject to change throughout the season at the discretion of the Board of Directors and the Recreation Committee. Changes to Rules and Regulations will be published on the Five Forks Village web site and posted at the pool guard station.

1. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk.
2. The pool is the private property of the Association. ONLY members, their families, guests, or tenants may use this amenity.
3. The pool attendants are responsible for, and authorized to, enforce all rules described here, and may evict and ban violators, as they deem necessary. Please remember that the pool attendants are not baby sitters and will not watch children as such.
4. The pool attendants have the authority to dismiss and ban anyone from the pool if their actions are judged to be hazardous or inappropriate in any manner. Failure to comply with the dismissal, until it can be discussed with the pool attendant's supervisors, may justify a longer period of dismissal, which will not be reduced, even if the original problem is resolved in the swimmer's favor.
5. The pool attendants have the authority to close the pool at any time in consideration of the health and safety of the swimmers. For safety reasons, the pool attendants may request the pool be cleared should the requirement of (1) lifeguard per (25) patrons be exceeded. The pool attendant will request additional attendants, and the pool will remain closed until additional attendants arrive. **The pool may be closed because of weather, at the discretion of the Pool Manager, based on the guidelines set forth by the American Red Cross.**
6. Pool attendants may not invite friends to enter the pool area. It is required that conversations with pool attendants be kept to a minimum.
7. Members must pick up snacks, wrappings, and all other debris including anything left by children in their care. Pool attendants are not expected to clean up after Members or their guest.
8. All members and guest WILL BE required to sign in and show their pool pass upon entering the pool area. Each member is required to show their pool pass each time upon entering the pool. There will be a \$5.00 fee for each lost pool pass. Pool attendants will monitor access to ensure that only residents and guests are admitted.
9. Guests must pay \$5.00 per day guest fee per person and can only be registered by the pool club member/manager. There is a 4 guest per household limit. Guests can be registered to attend the pool under adult supervision in the resident's absence. This can be renewed on a week to week basis. Guest registration procedures will be determined by the Board of Directors and may be changed at any time without notice.
10. No guest under the age of 14 will be allowed in the pool area without adult supervision. Guests 4 years old and under are free. The pool club member takes full responsibility of his/her guest and will be held accountable for the actions of his/her guest. All guests are required to read and follow the pool rules (posted on the bulletin board and on the community website).
11. The Association is not responsible for members, guests, or tenant's valuables or injuries.
12. Life jackets, goggles, "nerf-type" balls, and floats will be allowed in the pool at the pool attendant's discretion and permission. Water toys will be permitted in the wading pool. Use of inner tubes, flotation devices, etc. are prohibited except at designated times. Check with the pool attendant.

13. NO glassware or breakable plastic will be permitted in the pool enclosure. NO alcoholic beverages will be permitted in the pool enclosure. NO narcotics will be permitted in the pool enclosure, or on any property in and around the clubhouse.
14. Children under the age of 14 years must be accompanied by a parent or responsible guardian. A guardian must be 18 years or older.
15. Children who cannot swim must be within arm's reach of a parent or guardian who is responsible for supervising the child.
16. Running, pushing, horse playing and rough play in all forms will not be tolerated.
17. You may not enter the pool water with open sores, poison ivy, or other infectious or contagious conditions of any nature.
18. All swimmers must wear appropriate bathing suits. Diapers and sweatshirts are expressly forbidden. Pool attendants may request such persons so dressed to leave the pool area. Children in diapers and not toilet trained shall not be allowed in the main pool unless wearing the water proof swimmers designed for the pool.
19. The wading pool is provided for children under the age of 7 years. A parent or guardian must accompany a child at all times, as this area is not under the general supervision of pool attendants.
20. Plastic flotation devices, ring floats, water wings etc. are not considered life-saving devices.
21. Eating or smoking while in the pool or at its edge is prohibited. All persons are requested to dispose of their trash in the proper receptacles.
22. Radios/music devices may be brought into the pool area; however, the level of sound may be controlled by the pool manager.
23. No "flips" will be permitted from the side of the pool. **NO DIVING IS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME!**
24. Parents are asked to request that their children use toilet facilities prior to entering the pool, throughout the day, and to explain the sanitary importance thereof.
25. Baby Sitting Policy: Babysitters MUST BE registered through the proper paperwork. Homeowners will need to provide the babysitter with the registration form which is available on the community website at www.5forksvillage.com. Registration forms are to be dropped off at the clubhouse mailbox by the front entry door. The babysitter must be 18 years of age (ID is required). The babysitter will read and understand the pool rules and regulations. Babysitters may not bring any outside non-members (may not bring their own guest). Babysitters may not use the pool facility at any time, unless they are babysitting a Five Forks Village member's child.
26. NO private parties, including decorations of any type, are allowed during normal pool hours.
27. A FFV Pool Membership form must be completed and returned to the clubhouse mailbox by the front entry door. If there are any questions, please contact ACS West at (804) 282-7451. Pool passes will only be issued to the homeowner, spouse, and their legal dependents or renters with approved Owner Transfer of Rights Form.
